ULM Employee Holiday Schedule

Act 139 of the 1991 Regular Session of the Legislature provides that each institution of higher education shall designate a maximum of fourteen (14) legal holidays per calendar year to be observed as University holidays instead of observing the same number of State designated holidays.

Accordingly, the following University holidays are designated for 2021-2022 and will be observed without regard to otherwise designated State Holidays.
