## **FOOTNOTES CATALOG 2016-2017**

**1 A minimum grade** of "C" required in English 1001, 1002, the first non-developmental Math course, Biology and Chemistry if first in a sequence, and all Art courses.

MATHEMATICS (6 Hours) Six hours must be selected at a level no lower than college algebra. Qualified students may use Math 1013 as the first or second math requirement, but not both. Qualified students may use 1013, 1014, or 1031 for the second math requirement. Students may not use both Math 1014 and Math 1031 to satisfy the math requirement. Students may not use both Math 1012 and 1013 to satisfy the math requirement.

**2 HUMANITIES (9 Hours)** Nine hours must be selected from Literature, Foreign Languages, History, Communications, Philosophy, Classical Studies, Religious Studies, Interdisciplinary or courses designated as Humanities. The nine hours must

contain a minimum of 3 hours of Literature.

### 3 NATURAL/PHYSICAL SCIENCE (9 Hours),

Six hours must be from a single subject area of biological or physical science. Three hours must be from the other area (i.e., both physical and biological sciences must be taken). Students may receive credit toward degree in only one of PHYS 2003, PHYS 2007 and PSCI 1001. Also, students may not receive credit toward degree in both GEOS 1001 and GEOL 1001.

#### 4 SOCIAL/BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES (6 Hours)

Six hours must be selected from **Social Sciences**: Economics, Geography, Anthropology, Political Science, International Studies, Interdisciplinary and/or **Behavioral Sciences**: Psychology, Sociology. Three of these hours must be at the sophomore level or above.
