FOOTNOTES CATALOG 2016-2017

1 Minimum grades: In order for a person to be granted a Louisiana Teaching Certificate upon graduation, there must be an **overall grade point average of 2.5** on a 4.0 scale in all work to be credited toward a degree from an approved teacher education program. **There must be no grade below "C"** in any professional education course, psychology course, the teaching major or minor, or in specialized academic education, or general education courses.

MATHEMATICS (6 Hours) Six hours must be selected at a level no lower than college algebra. Qualified students may use Math 1013 as the first or second math requirement, but not both. Qualified students may use 1013, 1014, or 1031 for the second math requirement. **Students may not use both Math 1014 and Math 1031** to satisfy the math requirement. Students **may not use both Math 1012 and 1013** to satisfy the math requirement.

PRAXIS:

To be admitted to student teaching, and to earn the Bachelor's degree from The University of Louisiana at Monroe in a teaching field, persons must meet all eligibility requirements for Louisiana teacher certification, which include passing all parts of **PRAXIS I** (or a composite of 22 on the ACT) and **PRAXIS II**.

After completion of 45 hours - STUDENT MUST TAKE PRAXIS EXAM I if composite ACT score is not 22 or higher.

Second Semester Junior Year student MUST TAKE Art Content PRAXIS and PLT Exam.

Teacher candidates should consult advisor for testing locations and preparation for **PRAXIS examinations**.

2 HUMANITIES (9 Hours) The DOE requires completion of two histories in sequence and one literature.

3 NATURAL/PHYSICAL SCIENCE (9 Hours), Art Education students are expected to take integrated science courses BIOL 1050, plus six hours from CHEM 1050, PHYS 1050, or GEOS 1050.

4 SOCIAL/BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES (6 Hours) Art Education students must take 12 hours of Psychology to fulfill state education requirements, PSYC 2001, 2003, 2005, and 3001.

5 ART CHOICE (3 Hours), Art 2003, 2004 ceramics; Art 2041 crafts; Art 2057, 2058, 2059 or 2060 printmaking.
