FOOTNOTES CATALOG 2018-2019

1 Minimum grades: In order for a person to be granted a Louisiana Teaching Certificate upon graduation, there must be an **overall grade point average of 2.5** on a 4.0 scale in all work to be credited toward a degree from an approved teacher education program. **There must be no grade below "C" in any professional education course, psychology course, the teaching major or minor, or in specialized academic education, or general education courses.**

2 MATHEMATICS (6 Hours) Six hours must be selected at a level no lower than applied algebra. **Students may not use the following combinations to satisfy the math requirement:** Math 1009 and Math 1011, Math 1011 and Math 1013, Math 1012 and Math 1013, Math 1014 and Math 1031.

3 HUMANITIES (9 Hours) Nine hours must be selected from Literature, Foreign Languages, History, Communications, or courses designated as Humanities. The nine hours must contain a minimum of 3 hours of Literature.

4 NATURAL/PHYSICAL SCIENCE (9 Hours), Six hours must be from a single subject area of biological or physical science. Three hours must be from the other area (i.e., both physical and biological sciences must be taken). **Students may receive credit toward degree in only one of** PHYS 1001, PHYS 2003, PHYS 2007 and PSCI 1001. **Also, students may not receive credit toward degree in both** GEOS 1001 and GEOL 1001

5 SOCIAL/BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES (6 Hours)

Art Education students must take 12 hours of Psychology to fulfill state education requirements, PSYC 2001, 2003, 2005, and 3001.

6 ART CHOICE (3 Hours), Art 2003, 2004 ceramics; Art 2041 crafts; Art 2057, 2058, 2059 or 2060 printmaking.

7 PRAXIS - Application requirements, including passing scores on PRAXIS I, must be completed for admission to Teacher Education. Admission to Teacher Education required for enrollment in professional courses.

Prior to Residency, Teacher Candidates must meet eligibility requirements for Louisiana initial teacher certification, which includes passing scores on all applicable portions of PRAXIS I and PRAXIS II content before Residency 1 and PRAXIS II PLT before Residency 2.
