Important Math/English Information

Dear CAES faculty and staff,

Please note that students with a Math ACT of 17 are no longer eligible to enroll in the MATH 1000/1009 pair. And, students with an English ACT of 16 are no longer eligible to enroll in the ENGL 1000/1001 pair.

The information below should be useful as you advise students. Please note the opportunities that students now have to satisfy their developmental requirements on ULM's campus through LDCC (Louisiana Delta Community College).

The BoR now requires that the following students complete their developmental requirements at another institution of higher education:

- 1) Students with an ACT score below an 18 in Math or 17 in English. [NOTE NEW ACT CUTOFFS.]
- 2) Students who started at ULM before Fall 2015 and who have not yet completed the developmental requirement, and newly admitted transfer students who have not yet completed the developmental requirement.
- 3) Students who do not successfully complete their Math 1000 or English 1000 requirements within one academic year and with no more than two attempts.

Note: Students with two developmental requirements regardless of their ACT scores must complete both requirements at another institution of higher education.

This is what it means for PREP students:

MATH ACT 19 or above = Math 1009 or 1011

MATH ACT 18 = Math 1000/1009 pair [**NOTE CHANGE FROM LAST YEAR**: Students with a 17 are now excluded from this group]

MATH ACT 17 or below = Developmental math must be taken at LDCC or elsewhere

ENGL ACT 18 or above = ENGL 1001

ENGL ACT 17 = ENGL 1000/1001 pair [**NOTE CHANGE FROM LAST YEAR**: Students with a 16 are now excluded from this group]

ENGL ACT 16 or below = Developmental English must be taken at LDCC or elsewhere

LDCC is offering developmental courses for our students, which will be taught by LDCC faculty. The F2F sections will be taught on our campus. Here is how students will register for the courses:

STEP 1. ULM students must go to the LDCC web site... www.ladelta.edu click on "Admissions" then "Apply" (left column). They should follow the directions from that point and enroll as a "Visiting Student." LDCC will have to check off the application before students are allowed to register for the class.

STEP 2. After LDCC processes the application, the student will register for the developmental class on the LDCC page by entering the section CRN. Here are the available sections for the fall:
