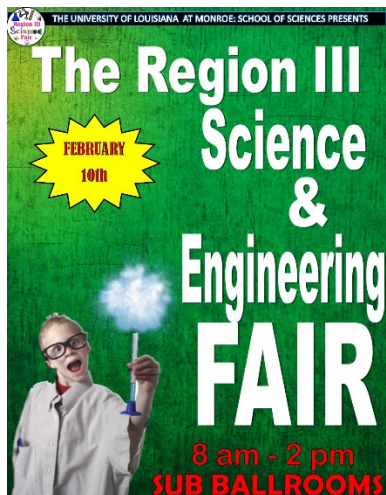


The Annual Region III Science and Engineering Fair



It's that time again! The University of Louisiana at Monroe host the Region III Science and Engineering Fair on Friday, Feb. 10, on the second floor of the Student Union building beginning at 8 a.m.

The fair consists of 19 categories that allows the first and second place winners to proceed to the Louisiana Science and Engineering Fair at Louisiana State University later this March. This year, only three parishes from the region are participating: Franklin, Morehouse and Ouachita. With 72 projects and 82 students competing, 90% of the students range from middle and junior high school.

Although the numbers decreased, the event allows the students to sharpen their science skills and mingle with other children their age on what they are learning. According to Mrs. Thompson, she love the many "ah ha" moments that she see taking place when students show off their projects, and with so many of the ULM faculty involved it shows even young middle school students that there is a place for them to grow at ULM!
