 - Improve Facility:

 - Ken Irvin completed schematic design on 10/21, no design contract, no loan time is ticking on cost & lost opportunities

- Hosted open house on 3/5/22, IAC and faculty met with 10 student / families.
- Enrollment numbers fall '21/ spring '22 = 151/122, Projected fall '22 = 113
 - Cancelled 6 courses for fall '22
- Only 18 completed students applications to date, compared to 100+ normally
