## Marriage and Family Counseling

Since 1983, the ULM Marriage and Family
Therapy Clinic has been serving the
community by helping individuals, couples,
and families navigate a variety of concerns
within the context of a relational system. The
facility works closely with other mental
health agencies in the community to provide
competent therapy to those seeking
assistance. Clients have described the clinic
as "a safe haven" where they are "treated
with respect, concern, and compassion."

Graduate students in the Marriage and Family Therapy Master's and Doctoral programs provide confidential services that adhere to Louisiana law and the ethical policies established by the American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy (AAMFT) and the American Counseling Association (ACA). AAMFT-approved supervisors, who also serve as the students' professors, give clinical guidance to the student therapists. Both the therapists' rigorous training and their respect for diversity ensure a professional experience for any client.
