2. Satisfactory completion of all Freshman year requirements with "C" (2.0) grade point average.
3. Minimum of "C" (2.0) grade point average required for all semester hours applied to degree, all courses in Major Thematic Concentration Group, and all 300 and 400 level courses.
4. 45 hours must be earned at 300 or 400 level. 15 of the 45 hours must be earned at 400 level. 12 of the 45 hours must be in Major Thematic Concentration Group.
5. The University Core is to be followed for completion of Required Courses.
6. Required Courses may not be used to meet any other degree requirements.
7. Students pursuing degrees with Major Thematic Concentrations in Groups I, II, or III must complete 6 hrs of one foreign language, either as elective hours or as part of a concentration.
