In addition to the university requirements for admission, all applicants must meet the following criteria:

Regular Admission

- a cumulative undergraduate GPA of 2.75 and above (based on a 4.0 scale), from a regionally accredited university **OR**
- 3.0 on last 60 hours of undergraduate coursework from a regionally accredited university

Conditional Admission

- a cumulative undergraduate GPA of 2.50 and above (based on a 4.0 scale), from a regionally accredited university **OR**
- 2.75 on last 60 hours of undergraduate coursework from a regionally accredited university **OR**
- Minimum formula score of 622.6 (2.2 GPA x 283 GRE)

Applicants for Alternative Certification degrees must meet the additional admission requirements specified for those programs.

Program Requirements

Applicants to all concentrations, except English as a Second Language (ESL), must hold a valid teacher's certificate in a field complimentary to the graduate concentration issued by the Louisiana State Department of Education or its equivalent. A total of 36 semester hours must be

earned for the degree regardless of concentration chosen. Successful candidates also earn their endorsement for Teacher Leader.

The Educational Diagnostics Concentration also requires a minimum of one academic year of teaching experience as a Special Education teacher, Mild/Moderate certification or 2 areas of special education certification (intellectual disabilities, specific learning disabilities, behavior disorder, or emotional disturbed), Graduate level Diagnostic Reading (3 credit hours), Graduate level Foundations of Reading (3 credit hours), Graduate level Behavior Intervention (3 credit hours).

Applicants to the M.Ed. in Curriculum & Instruction must hold a teacher's certificate issued by the Louisiana Department of Education or its equivalent. A minimum of 36 semester hours must be earned for the degree with 18 hours of Core and 18 hours of Approved Electives.

Pursuit of add-on certification(s) via the M.Ed. in Curriculum and Instruction must adhere to state requirements for the specific certification sought. Application for certification must be made by applicants directly to the Louisiana Department of Education. The School of Education Certification Office can advise students regarding these options. Successful candidates can also earn their endorsement for Teacher Leader.

A plan of study must be submitted the School of Education upon admission to the program and approved during the first semester of enrollment.
