Connecting Your TV & DISH Support

Whenever you hook up a new TV you will need to run a scan to receive all your channels. To do this, start by hitting the *Menu* or *Setup* button on your TV remote control. Scroll over until you find an option that says *channel scan* or *auto program*. If given the option, make sure you select *Cable* rather than *Air* or *Antenna* for your search. All TV's are different and may have different names for these features. If you do a channel scan and you are not able to get channels over 55 that would mean your TV does not have a QAM tuner in it. You can find a QAM tuner or a DTV converter at Amazon, Best Buy, or RadioShack.
