

STUDENT'S ACADEMIC RESPONSIBILITY

A student is personally responsible for completing all requirements established for a degree by the University and its colleges and departments. A student's advisor may not assume these responsibilities and may not substitute, waive, or exempt any established requirement or academic standard.

Students should see faculty advisors prior to registration. Faculty advisors are available to help students with course selection and course load. A student who does not have a faculty advisor should contact the academic department or college of the intended major. Students who do not consult their advisors before registering may prolong their programs of study and fail to meet University requirements.

Courses should be selected in accordance with prerequisites and with attention to advancing sequences. Students who register for classes for which they lack prerequisites or for courses taken out of required sequence can be dropped from those courses.
