Andrew Barber, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 12:00pm, on March 14, 2024 with 22 members present at ULM SOCM Rm 100.

Director's Report & Q&A – Dr Clint Martin

Dr. Clint Martin, SOCM Director, gave an update of the SOCM program-

- 26 companies attended career fair last week
- ULM rejoined ASC will attend upcoming Auburn meeting
- Attended ACCE Midyear meeting
- Student recruitment efforts ongoing
 - o Spring '24 Enrollment 129, up from 123 in Spring '23
 - o Ongoing outreach to HS counselors, 2 visits scheduled
 - o Recommended hiring consultant to help
- \$65k ordered new trimble surveying equipment from generous donation
- Plans to update surverying class to be geared more toward construction layout
- Temp Practices lab
 - Layout presentation
 - o 4 shipping containers with canopy
 - o Fenced with groundbreaker logo
 - o Currently being reviewed by "aesthetics" committee for university approval
 - o Est cost: \$80-100k
- Perm practices lab in La State Senate for approval this spring
- Faculty replacements- a couple applicants to interview next week







- o Currently one position advertised, but seeking to fill 2 full time professors
- Covering courses
 - George out sick
 - o D. Randall retiring Need mechanical adjunct
 - o 3 instructors covering all classes
 - Causing student unrest
 - Seeking bonus for the load instructors are covering
- Alumni outreach & student interaction
 - o Attended Shreveport alumni dinner last week
 - o Latest Groundbreaker newsletter sent last week
 - o Pancake Breakfast 3/19
 - o Golf Tournament 4/12
 - o CMSA clay shoot 4/19

- Would like to begin teaching Summer online "catch-up" courses
 - o Target next summer 2025
 - o Only for courses appropriate to be taught online
 - o Would require summer pay to faculty or adjunct faculty
- AI / Robotics

 - o AI writing papers, doing estimating, etc is a reality. Looking at integration in curriculum.
 - o Teaching it makes good sense.
 - o Robotics not likely to purchase any equipment, but need to teach about robotics.

 - o Breakfast last week with local delegation
 - Sold as a matched project to private industry dollars already spent at SOCM

 - Need to ensure aesthetically pleasing.
 - o Helpful to have a nice picture / rendering submitted to University
- Campus Master Plan Submitted last week. Campus upgrades could include:
