The April 22, 2013, meeting of the Commencement Committee (CC), held in Student Center 170, was called to order at 3:32 p.m. by Committee Chair Karen Crowley. The meeting was comprised of the following agenda items:

1. Welcome

Ms. Crowley welcomed members of the committee and thanked them for their attendance.

2. Review of Minutes – November 19, 2012

Minutes from the November 19, 2012, meeting were reviewed and approved (motion, Dr. Stewart; second, Ms. Hummel).

3. Overview of 2013 Spring Commencement

Ms. Crowley made the following remarks about the 2013 Spring Commencement:

- As of this date, we will award 829 degrees, with 708 candidates planning to walk; however, we can expect those
 numbers to change when we remove those who did not meet degree requirements and identify additional students who
 will graduate in absentia.
- State Senator Mike Walsworth will deliver the commencement address.
- Dr. Bette Kauffman will be the announcer for the ceremony.
- Dr. Mark Clark will be the soloist.

4. Rehearsal and Ceremony Dates/Times

Ms. Crowley called Committee members' attention to the following dates and times for the 2013 Spring rehearsal and ceremony:

- Rehearsal Friday, May 10, 2013, 9:00 a.m.; all committee members report to Coliseum 43 at 8:45 a.m.
- Ceremony Saturday, May 11, 2013, 10:00 a.m.; all committee members report to Coliseum 43 at 8:45 a.m.

5. Preparation for Rehearsal and Ceremony

The following items were discussed in preparation for the upcoming rehearsal and ceremony:

- Candidate/guest information: Informational documents for students and guests are posted on the <u>Registrar's page</u> under the *Commencement* link.
- Review of instructions and assignments: In Ms. Williamson's absence, Ms. Crowley directed committee members to the *Practice and Commencement Instructions for Marshals* handout and the Fant-Ewing diagram on which assignments are indicated.
- Volunteer Sign-Up: Committee members were asked to volunteer to hang/remove signs and labels, as well as distribute rehearsal packets.
- Live web-cast of ceremony: We will again offer a live web-cast of the commencement ceremony.

6. Other Business

- Several committee members noted that they cannot attend rehearsal because they are giving finals during that time (conflict created by earlier rehearsal/ceremony dates). There remains no alternative.
- Dr. Stewart asked that candidates continue to be reminded to say their names loudly at the final check.
- Mr. Williamson asked whether there are high school graduation ceremonies in Fant-Ewing the week of our ceremony. Ms. Crowley reported that she has not been informed of the schedule for the venue.
- Mr. Williamson suggested that personal belongings of faculty could be secured in Coliseum 18 during the ceremony.
