University Curriculum Committee End-of-Year Report

The University Curriculum Committee (UCC) has been a very active committee. The committee had regular committee meeting every month this academic year with the final meeting to be held May 7th, 2015. The UCC has looked at curriculum issues from every college and maintained the core curriculum for the University. To date this academic year, the UCC has produced 143 pages of meeting minutes related to 139 individual curricular changes a long with multiple other memorandums for catalog corrections and curriculum updates. While the UCC is still a very time consuming committee it continues to be an important committee. The UCC continues to sustain the academic oversight of curricular changes across campus. One final note on activities of the committee relates to the Curriculog curriculum system from Digital Architecture. We completed design and implementation of the forms in May of 2014 and the system was to be used this academic year but it was not used due to a configuration issue between Digital Architecture and ULM. Chance Eppinette has been working to resolve the issue and I hope to use the system next year.

At this point I would generally give a list of members that should be rotated off the committee but with the large number of committee members that will be leaving for reason outside of the committee including retirement, leaving the University and change in campus duties I think that current members that are on the committee should stay on the committee to insure continuity of the committee.
