<p>Athletics and Compliance: (Erika Cheung, Scott McDonald) -- Athletics is going into PREP preparation for next year. They continue to work with groups to get all athletes addressed. Sun Belt is pushing for soccer and volleyball to be added to summer access, like football and Mens/Womens basketball. That vote will occur in April. There is concern regarding the financial impact of adding 40 additional students to current system. Athletics is in full swing for outdoor sports this season. Beach volleyball will have their final tournament on campus at the end of April. There will be a banquet at Bayou Pointe on May 2 for student athletes. Hawk Cup, as discussed at last meeting, is doing well with a significant uptake in community service this semester.</p> <p>FAR/Academic Integrity and Compliance Subcommittee: (Mary Adams) -- At this time, still not scheduled to attend a practice as a committee. Ericka will check on beach volleyball schedule to coordinate our attendance. Leigh and Mary want to attend a SACS meeting for faculty nomination awards. Sun Belt will be doing the awards this summer, so they would like to attend the April SACS meeting in order to have nominations for the Sun Belt meeting. The University is currently in the process of hiring a mental health counselor dedicated to the student athletes. Interviews are starting this week.</p> <p>Equity and Student-Athlete Well-being: (L. Hersey) -- Jan Daniel will be coming to speak to student athletes and staff regarding suicide awareness.</p> <p>Governance: (TBD) no report</p> <p>Academics: (Carmen Wright, Anthony Malta, Barbara Michaelides) Carmen -- Advising has begun for Summer/Fall. Athletic drop dates for full semester courses is 1 week prior to the academic calendar drop date. 8 week classes drop dates coincide with academic calendar. Suzie Seeber will teach a 2nd summer session Math 1009 class that will be face-to-face and pencil/paper tests. Mental health counselor interviews ongoing and dedicated to athletes. Warhawk Way continues to be defined: planning banquet with awards, breakfast for graduating seniors Friday before graduation, supplemental graduation for track/baseball teams will be May 16th. Win for athletics in that womens soccer member declared ineligible by Sun Belt. Through hard work on part of the advising team and Athletics, the decision was reversed and student was deemed eligible to play.
