### **Current Content:**

The Master of Science in Psychology offers specialized tracks in Psychometrics, Criminal, and General Psychology. Basic requirements common to all three tracks are PSYC 5022(4), PSYC 5023(3), and PSYC 5061(3). The General track requires the addition of PSYC 5002(3), PSYC 5029(6), and 17 hours of electives (from specifically identified course groups) for a total of 36 hours. The additional required courses in the Psychometric track include PSYC 5009(3), PSYC 5011(3), PSYC 5015(3), PSYC 5018(3), PSYC 5034(3), PSYC 5052(3), PSYC 5071(2), and six hours of psychology electives (from specifically identified course groups) for a total of 36 hours. The Criminal track requires the addition of PSYC 5009(3), PSYC 5018(3), CJUS 5001(3), CJUS 5005(3), CJUS 5040(3), CJUS 5055(3), CJUS 5076(3), and five hours of psychology electives (from specifically identified courses) for a total of 36 hours.

**Proposed Content:** 

The Master of Science in Psychology offers specialized tracks in Psychometrics, Forensic, and General Psychology. Basic requirements common to all three tracks are PSYC 5022(3), PSYC 5023(3), and PSYC 5061(3).
