## Master of Arts in Teaching: New Student Agreement

## As a new candidate for a Master of Arts in Teaching, I understand and agree to the following:

- 1. For all MAT coursework, I must maintain the required graduate school average, and not make any grade below a "C." I cannot make more than two C's while in the program.
- 2. Internship is considered to be my full-time teaching position, and is a requirement to graduate with a MAT, and receive a Louisiana Teacher Certification.
- 3. To be eligible for Internship, I must complete the Online Summer Institute and pass the nine hours of pre-requisite courses offered in Summer II. I must be employed, and provide proof of employment as the teacher of record, teaching at least 51% in my content area and grade level.
  - A. If I drop or do not complete any one of these courses, I will not be eligible to begin my Internship the fall, even if I have secured employment.
  - B. Internship must begin in the Fall Semester and last a full consecutive year.
- 4. It is imperative that I regularly check my ULM e-mail account. Failing to do so does not excuse me from any deadlines, or completing program requirements.
- 5. I am responsible for regularly checking the MAT CANVAS advising page for important program information and updates.
- 6. All exit requirements outlined in my program plan must be completed for me to graduate from the program, and receive a Louisiana Teacher Certification.
- 7. If, for any reason, I have to leave or take time off from the program, I must inform my advisor, Jessica McAllister, before the end of the term.
