2021-2022 LETTER OF INTENT TO ATTEND FUTURE PART-OF-TERM COURSES Spring 2022

Any student, who receives federal financial aid, receives it under the assumption that the student will attend school for the entire period for which the assistance is awarded. Dropping and/or failing to attend courses during the **Spring** term may require the Financial Aid Office to return a portion of your aid leaving you owing a balance to ULM.

However, a student is not considered to have withdrawn from the university if the school obtains a written confirmation, from the student at the time of the withdrawal, that he/she will attend a course that begins later in the same payment period. This confirmation must be obtained at the time of withdrawal, even if the student has already registered for subsequent courses.

This form must be received by the Financial Aid Office no later than 5 working days from the date the student was determined to be withdrawn or dropped from a class.
