Inter-professional Education Training: [From Roxie Stewart] Representatives from the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences will be on campus for Interprofessional Education training and simulation demonstrations. This training would benefit all COP faculty, especially those who may be involved in current or future IPE facilitation and/or who serve as preceptors. There will be three modules:

Module 1 – Will focus on IPE core competencies and clinical care practice, as well as facilitator training.

Module 2 – Will focus on preceptor competencies, teaching and learning, and designing events.

Module 3 – Will focus on simulation scenarios, videos, and hands-on activities.
