1. WHEREAS, Within the bounds of the Constitution and Bylaws, the Staff Senate has the authority to adopt bylaws, rules, and resolutions to fulfill its responsibilities, and,

2. WHEREAS, The ULM Staff Senate can only debate and vote, by a two-thirds vote of the senators during a regular meeting where a quorum is present, on amendments and,

3. WHEREAS, The ULM Staff Senate sees it fit to continually update the Constitution and Bylaws to reflect the growth of the organization, so,

4. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; to amend Article II, Section 5.B.b and for subletter B.b.i to read as follows:

Section 5. Replacement

b.i. Attendance must be in-person unless electronic attendance is approved prior to the meeting.

5. THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; to amend Article VI, Section 3. and for subletter G. to read as follows:

G. A senator must get approval at least 24 hours in advance to attend regularly scheduled in-person meetings electronically. If the Staff Senate President does not grant prior approval, the senator will be marked as absent and unexcused.
