 - She is dedicated to creating a clear pathway for students from recruitment to graduation.
 - She will ensure that each area provides these clear and concise service.
 - She will prioritize Student Life to increase retention.
 - Division priorities
 - Strengthen student journey from start to finish
 - Ace's Place is a good determining factor if we are achieving this. The fewer calls to Ace's Place the better.
 - Stabilizing and strengthening enrollment
 - Elevating student life as a retention driver
 - Improving internal communication
 - Building a culture of consistency

- President Webb asked about where ULM is currently with recruitment:
 - ULM had a 22% increase in freshman in Fall 2024, but ULM was down from that for Fall 2025.
- Past President Mejia asked how much out of state recruitment ULM does?
 - Currently, ULM does not do as much as they would like due to the high expenses that are required.
- Senator Welch asked about what recruitment looked like for online majors.
 - They don't do a lot specifically. They provide all the information for the online majors in addition to the on-campus and let applicants decide their path. No specific recruit method geared towards online currently.
